Rosé

NV Wildekrans Estate 'Caresse Marine' Sweet Rosé *Bot River* 105

A faint cherry red colour models the look of this intense blend of red berry fruit with candy floss sweetness.

Riebeek Cellars Pinotage Rosé *Swartland* 40 110

This Pinotage Rosé boasts a burst of fresh flavours with a sweet strawberry and cherry tang.

NV 'Madame' Semi-Sweet Rosé *Western Cape* 115

This is a semi-sweet, fruity wine with aromas of fresh strawberries, berries and honey. It is an ideal luncheon wine, paired well with sushi, salads and fish.

Lourensford 'River Garden' Rosé *Helderberg* 125

Perfect for pairing with seafood such as oysters, shellfish and sushi, this sparkling rosé presents a bold fragrant of sweet fruit flavours, while maintaining a fresh, crisp taste.

Anthonij Rupert 'Protea' Rosé *Franschhoek* 145

This unique Pinot Noir Rosé offers a fresh and fruity, yet dry rosé. Packed with bursts of cherry and melon flavours, this deep pink coloured rosé will compliment your favourite meal.

White Blends

NVA Madrinha' Light Bubbly White Wine *Western Cape* 115

A semi-sweet, fruity white wine, with aromas of fresh fruit, fresh cut grass and honey. It's ideal as a luncheon wine – great for pairing with sushi, salads and fish.

Buitenverwaching 'Buiten Blanc' *Constantia* 145

Offering a variety of fruit flavours, this full-bodied Sauvignon Blanc based blend includes a mix of ripe gooseberries, green melon, green peppers, and hints of tropical fruit.

Lourensford Chardonnay Pinot Noir *Helderberg* 165

The Chardonnay component contributes to the richness and backbone of the wine, while the Pinot Noir adds fruit and elegance with characteristic hints of ripe berries and a touch of spice. It's excellent for pairing with poultry, cream-based dishes, veal, or salmon.

NV Neil Patterson 'Sulphite-Free' *Stellenbosch* 195

This blend is inviting to the nose, offering a good mix of tropical fruit and subtle, fresh green undertones. Each sip invites you to enjoy another taste of this dry and crispy, complex wine.

Haute Cabrière Chardonnay Pinot Noir *Franschhoek* 240

This wine has a unique balance as the Chardonnay contributes elegance, and the Pinot Noir offers fruity flavour intensity. This Vintage is refined with a firm acidity and an abundance of ripe fruit on the bouquet and palate.

Sauvignon Blanc

Riebeek Cellars Sauvignon Blanc *Swartland* 35 110

This well-balanced Sauvignon Blanc boasts zesty flavours and a crisp finish that leaves a refreshing taste on the palate.

Anthonij Rupert 'Protea' Sauvignon Blanc *Franschhoek* 140

Bold, tropical fig and gooseberry aromas with a floral grassy undertone, sums up the gist of this wine. Gravelly flint entry onto the palate, with a zesty lime cordial and white pepper bite, you will also taste crisp, live acidity.

Rhebokskloof Sauvignon Blanc *Paarl* 50 150

Well-balanced wine with flavours of green figs and passion fruit, it weighs well on the palate with a lasting, crisp finish.

Lourensford Sauvignon Blanc *Helderberg* 195
Pungent tropical fruit flavours of Cape gooseberries, ripe figs and passion fruit, supported by a fresh crispness of kiwi fruit and green pepper with lemon grass undertones and a creamy finish.

Guardian Peak Sauvignon Blanc *Stellenbosch* 195
Pale green in colour, an initial impression is that of tropical fruit, elegant gooseberry flavours, and lime notes. The hint of flintiness generates an impression of a complex, yet refreshing wine.

Boschendal 1685 Sauvignon Blanc *Franschhoek* 215
This straw-coloured wine has an aroma of herbs and tropical fruit, with hints of lime and green fig. These complex flavours carry through to the creamy, harmonious palate, adding to the mineral zesty finish - it is ready to drink and ideal for partnering with smoked fish, seafood, creamy poultry or veal dishes.

Buitenverwachting Sauvignon Blanc *Constantia* 220
The wine has a pale, lemon-yellow colour and a bouquet reminiscent of green figs, hints of gooseberries and green peppers. It is essentially a dry, full bodied wine with a long lingering finish.

The Goose Sauvignon Blanc *Outeniqua Mountains, George* 220
The Goose Sauvignon Blanc offers an exciting and unique tasting experience. The bouquet of the wine is Cape floral driven with a sure tropical distinction. Hints of gooseberry support the nose. The wine presents an interesting zesty structure to the palate that showcases full-bodied character.

Durbanville Hills 'Rhinofields' Sauvignon Blanc *Durbanville* 225
The nose is a well-balanced combination of fruity green pepper, gooseberry and asparagus with earthy flavours. Enjoy a crisp, fresh aftertaste of lime and winter melon, that lingers long after the wine has left the palate.

Cederberg Sauvignon Blanc *Cederberg* 260
Enjoy this aromatic Sauvignon Blanc with grassy notes, white asparagus undertones and strong hints of capsicum, gooseberries and lemon zest. It's refreshing, crisp acidity finishes off the initial sensation of creaminess on the mid-palate. It is perfect for pairing with fresh fish, as well as shellfish and red meat.

Cape of Good Hope 'Altima' Sauvignon Blanc *Citrusdal Mountain* 275
Bold aromas typical of Sauvignon Blanc enjoy fragrances of grass, herbs, and fynbos pungency too. The mouth is equally expressive with vibrant lemon peel crispness; taut acidity keeps the palate focused, while good minerality and liveliness is present throughout.

Chenin Blanc

Riebeek Cellars Chenin Blanc *Swartland* 35 100
Well-balanced Chenin Blanc that boasts fresh zesty flavours with a lasting, crisp finish.

Rhebokskloof Chenin Blanc *Paarl* 145
Experience smoky aromas of black pepper, berries and dark chocolate, complemented by silky ripe tannins and delicate spicy oak nuances.

Wildekrans Estate Chenin Blanc *Bot River* 155
Sweet straw and pineapples on the nose, followed by a ripe flavour and crisp acidity on the palate. The complex taste has a lasting and pleasing finish that calls for more.

Cederberg Chenin Blanc *Cederberg* 215
Renowned for being a consistent Cape benchmark for last decade, made from older vines and always impressive! This Chenin Blanc is recognised for its powerful nose of grapefruit, melon and citrus flavours, tingling crispness, and lasting fruit laden finish.

Cape of Good Hope 'Van Lill & Visser' Chenin Blanc *Citrusdal Mountain* 280
Toasty notes supports nectarine, apricot and peach aromas on the bouquet. The palate is rich, rounded, and bold, with the oak immediately apparent - but not overwhelming the ripe stone fruit elements of apricot, nectarine and peach which remain pure, and well defined.

Chardonnay

Anthony Rupert 'Protea' Chardonnay *Franschhoek* 50 145
Peach and apricot aromas mingle with grapefruit and a light orange blossom overlay on the nose. The same stone fruit flavours of white peach and nectarine are immediately apparent on the light, tangy and crisp palate. A light lemon zest note vies with a rich, honeyed nuance on the long, balanced finish.

Riebeek Cellars 'A Few Good Men' Chardonnay *Swartland* 150
This unwooded style of Chardonnay offers an accessible wine with the body of the Chardonnay grape without the oak and buttery flavours often associated with this cultivar. The colour is a brilliant green-gold and the style is dry but fruity. The nose has exceptional tropical flavours that follow through on the palate with a well-rounded finish of lingering citrus.

Boschendal 1685 Chardonnay *Franschhoek* 220
This bold wine is big on aroma and flavours, combining a citrus, cinnamon, nutmeg nose with zesty citrus and ripe tropical fruit on the palate. Well balanced, the soft, creamy character from barrel fermentation and maturation, adds to the complexity and roundness of the wine. Ideally served with fish and shellfish, poultry and soft cheeses.

Durbanville Hills 'Rhinofields' Chardonnay *Durbanville* 260
Rich straw colour with hints of green, citrus, peach, dried apricots and butterscotch on the nose, backed by well-integrated wood. Full-bodied and crisp on the palate with a lemon-lime finish.

Cape of Good Hope 'Serruria' Chardonnay *Citrusdal Mountain* 360
Bright and fresh, featuring a delicious core of Jon Gold apple, white peach and chamomile notes, harnessed by finely beaded acidity. The long, focused finish sports a slightly chiseled edge. It should open up nicely with some cellaring – ready to drink or cellar for the three to five years.

Rhebokskloof 'Sandstone Grove Reserve' Chardonnay *Paarl* 400
From its pale gold colour, to the peach, lemon-peel and buttered-toast character, this wine is designed to please. Matured in French Oak barrels, it is full-bodied with enough lingering freshness to accompany a range of dishes.

Meerlust Chardonnay *Stellenbosch* 495
Complex, appealing nose with pear, citrus and floral notes developing into lemon, cream, oatmeal and marzipan richness. On the palate, the wine is full-bodied and generous, yet smooth and balanced by crisp acidity. There is ripe tropical fruit and creaminess balanced by a pure minerality, typical of the variant.

White Cultivars

Anthony Rupert Terra Del Capo Pinot Grigio *Franschhoek* 455
This Pinot Grigio has Granny Smith apple, white pear and slight tropical notes. The notes follow through on the palate, delivering a smooth and well-balanced acidity.

Simonsig 'Gewürztraminer' *Stellenbosch* 199
Faint, straw colour with exotic aromas of litchi, rose petals, honey, and a touch of Turkish Delight. There is perfect harmony between the fruit, acidity, and sweetness, which makes this the ideal food companion.

Riebeek Cellars 'Kasteelberg' Viognier *Swartland* 280
This oak-matured Viognier is a voluptuous wine with lovely nutty and light buttery flavours. It is well balanced by a floral perfume on the nose. The style is rich, ripe, and well-structured to result in an elegant wine, ideally suited to complement suave dinners.

Cape of Good Hope 'Laing' Semillon *Citrusdal Mountain* 330
Distinctive with citrus oil and matchstick notes leading the way for bracing nectarine, tangerine and green plum fruit flavours. The finish is tinged with straw, but stays taut, holding an echo of quinine. Ready to drink or cellar for three to five years. Limited stock available.

Red Blends

NV The Godfather 'O Padrinho' *Western Cape* 110
This Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot blend has a rich nose of berries, chocolate and soft black fruits. This wine is well paired with tuna, rump steak, or on its own.

Rhebokskloof Flat Rock Red Blend *Paarl* 60 180
A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. It displays powerful plum and cassis on the nose with savoury ripe tannins and a smooth juicy palate appeal. This wine goes well with red meats.

Buitenverwachting 'Meifort' *Constantia* 190
Full-bodied and complex Cabernet Franc based red blend. Its warm and inviting nose shows elegant plum and red cherry characters, combined with spicy oak and tobacco characters. Deep ruby colour with a long fruit full finish.

Boschendal 1685 'S&M' *Franschhoek* 240
This blend boasts a voluptuous body of dark, deep plum with a rim of warm ruby red colours. Notes of soft white pepper spice and dark cherries with hints of chargrilled aromas on the nose are prominent. Rounded, lush plum with a rich mulberry concentration of the fruity body from the Mourvèdre, opens onto the palate, softening the youthful spice, oak and a tease of dark chocolate of the Shiraz.

Villiera Domaine Grier Odyssea *Stellenbosch* 300
Odyssea forms part of the story that reflects the influence of both the old and new world. The wine clearly expresses the minerality and spice expected from Villiera Wines, supported by fruit and a hint of aniseed. It is naturally fresh with good palate weight and balance. Limited stock available.

Meerlust 'Rubicon' *Franschhoek* 825
The Rubicon is a classic red blend of iconic Cape wine. Deep, youthful colour and intense near purple hue; classic Rubicon nose with violets, ripe plum, cedar wood and intense spiciness. A typical liquorice note also evident on the nose. The palate is full bodied, structured but packed with fresh dark fruit and rounded, linear tannins.

Cabernet Sauvignon

Anthony Rupert 'Protea' Cabernet Sauvignon *Franschhoek* 60 170
Expect to find typical fruit cake and blackcurrant leaf on the nose with a gentle hint of spices, adding an extra dimension and interest. Tasty, ripe cassis and blackberry flavour is complemented by cocoa and turned-earth nuance in the mouth. Deep, dark, delicious and tantalising.

NV Neil Patterson 'Sulphite-Free' Cabernet Sauvignon *Stellenbosch* 190
This Cabernet Sauvignon has a bright, full aroma of red fruit on the nose, with a lively palate on first taste. Red fruit flavours dominate until smooth, soft tannins fill the palate, adding just enough weight for a rounded, lasting finish. This wine is lighter than expected as no sulphites have been added, yet it exhibits the body, tannin and weight that will allow it to age well for some years to come.

Guardian Peak "Frontier" Cabernet Sauvignon *Stellenbosch* 200
Superb red fruit aromas of raspberry and plum are supported by hints of black cherry and cedar wood. The ripe red fruits from the nose come through on the palate. There is a subtle fynbos that backs up the medium to full mouth feel. This wine has a nice firm structure with a lengthy red fruit finish.

Cederberg Cabernet Sauvignon *Cederberg* 350
High altitude cabernet vineyards that have a longer ripening period give rise to this phenomenal wine. Loads of blackcurrants with cedar wood undertones on the nose. The elegant oak expresses hints of smokiness and tobacco leaf creating a complex wine with a velvety finish on the palate. A prime example of a well-crafted South African Cabernet Sauvignon.

Meerlust Cabernet Sauvignon Stellenbosch 650
The Meerlust Cabernet Sauvignon has an intense, vivid purple colour with slight gradation at the rim. On the nose, the wine shows intense cassis, plum, and classic cedar wood cigar box notes with lifted dark fruit aromas. On the palate, the wine is full-bodied and impressively structured. Intense blackcurrant and plum fruit bolstered by refined tannins and fresh natural acidity.

Merlot

Riebeek Cellars Stellenbosch 40 115
Beautiful flavours and a nose with distinctive red berries and well-integrated wood flavours. The palate is velvety and smooth with a long juicy aftertaste that boasts berries.

Anthonij Rupert 'Protea' Merlot Franschhoek 165
This wine presents blueberry, mulberry and plum aromas in abundance. The mouth is full of juicy, dark berry fruit - the blueberry, mulberry and plum promised by the nose - with a light cocoa sheen. Good body, concentration and depth to the palate which manages to be both soft and yielding, but retains a solid core. There's a lovely freshness which runs all the way to a rich cocoa finish.

Guardian Peak Merlot Stellenbosch 195
Ruby red in colour, clean fresh aromas of red fruit with hints of chocolate. Plum and red berry flavours filter through on the palate with a long, elegant finish. This intense, fruit-driven example of a typical South African Merlot was made for early enjoyment and will improve over the next two to three years.

Boschendal 1685 Merlot Franschhoek 245
On the nose, pronounced ripe mulberry flavours play around with soft touches of vanilla and expressive dark chocolate richness. The palate follows through with plush mulberry flavours, but this time redder and vibrant, supported by refined wood tannins and finishing with a combined aftertaste of savoury fynbos and very subtle freshly roasted coffee beans.

Lourensford Merlot Helderberg 255
Deep ruby colour, red berry aromas with strawberry, prominently greets the nose. Herbal notes with hints of oak and vanilla, with herbaceous fruity, toasted oak finish.

Durbanville Hills 'Rhinofields' Merlot Durbanville 280
Striking deep red in colour with plenty aromas of berry fruit, strawberries and cherries along with hints of mint. On the palate this medium to full-bodied wine displays berry fruit flavours.

Meerlust Merlot Stellenbosch 620
Deep, youthful purple hue with a ruby rim. A typical Merlot nose with juicy plum and mulberry fruit, lifted spiciness and hints of dark chocolate and graphite. The palate offers generous, ripe, pure Merlot fruit with refreshing acidity, structured yet silky tannins, and pronounced length and minerality.

Shiraz

Anthonij Rupert 'Protea' Shiraz Stellenbosch 165
A pleasant bouquet of black cherry, plum and smoky charcuterie with highlights of pepper and spice. More of the same can be found on the palate which is big, broad and well-structured. It is a muscular wine with a commanding presence, though restrained and silky.

Guardian Peak Shiraz Stellenbosch 195
A beautiful and well integrated Shiraz with notes of black fruits, cassis and Cajun spice on the nose. The above, with its round tannins and a solid structure creates an elegant wine that is true to its varietal character.

Wildeckrans Estate Shiraz Bot River 225
From nurtured vineyards, these grapes are harvested in the early hours of the morning to preserve fruit essence. This Shiraz has matured in French Barriques for 15 months. Its intense showing of fruit aromas result in a mouth-filling palate packed with vanilla and spice.

Boschendal 1685 Shiraz *Franschhoek* 245
Generous red fruit with hints of cassis and pepper on the nose. Sumptuous concentrated mulberry and fleshy plum fruit with white pepper integrated with oak spice. Soft ripe tannins offer richness to the wine making process, whilst allowing it to retain structure to support at least five years in the bottle.

Riebeeck Cellars 'Kasteelberg' Shiraz *Swartland* 320
Often referred to as Shiraz Country, the Riebeeck Valley is renowned for exceptional Shiraz wines. The Kasteelberg Shiraz is a lively rich wine, full-bodied with a subdued smokiness on the nose and a palate of ripe fruit and interesting spice. Well-balanced and smooth, the aftertaste lingers with the exciting flavours of Christmas pudding.

Cederberg Shiraz *Cederberg* 415
A complex Shiraz filled with intense red fruit, mulberry, and cherries on the nose. Well-balanced with hints of elegant oak, sweet spice and vanilla. Red berries follow through on the palate and finishes off with a smooth lingering sensation. It is a well-crafted Shiraz that allows you to cellar the wine for a few years for developing into a sensational wine.

Rhebokskloof 'Black Marble Hill Reserve' Shiraz *Paarl* 570
With dark plum aromas, aromatic spice and black pepper nuances from the oak aging process. This wine confidently reflects a bold and generous Shiraz style.

Pinotage

Rhebokskloof Pinotage *Paarl* 150
This wine shows typical cultivar character with lots of red berry fruit flavours and is complemented by subtle oak aromas.

Kleine Zalze Pinotage *Stellenbosch* 155
The blend of different terroirs creates a subtle and stylish wine. It is presented by a deep red colour with intense mulberry and black plum fruit flavours. Maturation in the French oak barrels adds a soft complexity with well integrated firm tannins. It can best be described as subtle and stylish with a hint of spice – established by the cool climate grapes.

Wildeckrans Estate Pinotage *Bot River* 215
Spicy, with intriguing aromas of savoury blue and black fruit, smoky embers, cured meat and dried tobacco. Savory and balanced on the medium to full-bodied palate with flavours of curry leaf, American oak, and stewed plums.

Cape of Good Hope 'Basson' Pinotage *Citrusdal Mountain* 510
Experience whiffs of dark berry fruit and spicy plums, with a light floral nuance. Immediately soft and rounded in the mouth, with ripe red and black fruit. A deep mocha/cocoa richness then becomes apparent, while its silky smooth, texture demonstrates leashed power and refinement. Lovely toned down but integrated oak use, frames the fruit beautifully.

Pinot Noir

The Goose Pinot Noir *Outeniqua Mountains, George* 420
The Goose Pinot Noir's dark, ruby colour reveals aromas of spice, strawberry, raspberries and very sweet, dark cherries. This great wine of Walker Bay origin, is a full-bodied, powerful wine and yet fruit dominated. It is packed with loads of cassis, red cherries and plums.

Haute Cabrière Pinot Noir *Franschhoek* 510
Enticing, concentrated aromas of ripe cherries seduce the palate and linger long in the mouth. The overall impression is pure elegance in comparison to previous vintages.

Meerlust Pinot Noir *Franschhoek* 630
Intense, yet translucent ruby-purple in colour. The nose has lifted scents of summer fruit, red cherry, strawberry, musky perfume and a distinct minerality. The palate is medium-bodied with pure Pinot Noir fruit flavours of plum and red cherry, supported by a fine, densely textured tannin structure which adds to the volume and vivacity of the wine.

Methode Cap Classique / Sparkling Wine

Riebeek Cellars 'Pieter Cruythoff' Sparkling Wine *Swartland* 55 160
Pieter Cruythoff was one of Jan van Riebeeck's scouts who came down the Kasteelberg Mountain to discover the fertile Riebeek valley. This range of wine honours his memory.

Pierre Jourdan Cuvee Belle Rosé Methode Cap Classique *Franschhoek* 285
Belle Rosé has the faintest tinge of salmon pink, a lively presentation of Pinot Noir flavours, and a fine pleasing mousse. It reveals an elegant dry finish.

Wildeckrans 'Chenin Brut' Methode Cap Classique *Bot River* 295
This unique Chenin Blanc Methode Cap Classique boasts cookies and cream, and delicate fruits on the nose. Experience distinct freshness, followed by a crisp, clean finish. This wine goes exceptionally well with sushi and oysters, complementing every bite.

Anthony Rupert 'L'Ormarins Brut' Methode Cap Classique *Franschhoek* 300
A delicate peach hue, constant stream of fine bubbles, appealing aroma of candied apple, citrus pith and light flinty, limestone nuance. Rounded, creamy, broad, and textured in the mouth - elegant and statuesque. Its lasting aftertaste finishes on a light lemon zest note.

Rhebokskloof 'Brut' Methode Cap Classique *Paarl* 335
This light wine is made from Chardonnay grapes. It is a French style sparkling wine, showing a complex bouquet of fruit flavours with some biscuit notes. This complements shellfish, especially langoustines.

Boschendal 'Brut Rosé' Methode Cap Classique *Franschhoek* 350
Exceptionally pleasing to the eye as well as the palate, this Brut Rosé sparkles with versatility, making it ideal for enjoying on its own or in a bubbly and al fresco environment – paired with seafood, summer salads, and chicken dishes.

Cederberg 'Brut' Methode Cap Classique *Cederberg* 430
Prepared with a traditional French method which allows a second fermentation to take place in the bottle, the extended period on lees, affords time to add to the creamy complexity of this sparkling wine. It resulted in a bouquet of baked brioche, apples with fresh lemon and grapefruit aromas that entices your senses.

Champagne

Moët & Chandon 'Brut' Champagne 1200
Its delicate vinous aroma develops into an elegant, toasty nose with pear, apple and citrus overtones. This champagne has a delicate well-balanced palate. However, at the same time, it is complex with great depth, infused with flavours of butter, brioche and a high concentration of candied fruit, ginger bread and vanilla.

Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin 'Brut Rosé' Champagne 1850
The impression here is elegant overall, but there is a firm backbone of acidity that is finely meshed with the range of flavours, including white raspberry, spiced plum, biscuit, pink grapefruit zest and a base note of smoky minerality. Ready to drink, or mature for two to three years.

<i>Bollinger 'Brut' Champagne</i>	1950
A blend that is consistent in style and quality. Complex yet elegant, inducing ginger, jasmine, citrus and honey aromas and flavours - emphasised by biscuit tones.	
<i>Billecart-Salmon 'Brut Rosé' Champagne</i>	2600
The production 'secrets' and vinification method of this cuvée dates back to the origins of the House of Billecart-Salmon, and have been handed down for seven generations. The Brut Rosé is a blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier and Pinot Noir, vinified as a white wine, with a small percentage of Pinot Noir vinified as a red wine. Its special method of vinification gives this cuvée a light, elegant bouquet, followed by a fresh finish.	
<i>Dom Perignon 'Brut' Champagne</i>	4150
Fresh, crystalline and sharp, the first nose unveils an unusual dimension of an aquatic vegetal world, with secret touches of white pepper and gardenia. Notes of liquorice and dried ginger linger on the palate. The finish gradually unfurls and then settles. It is best described as smooth, mellow and all-encompassing.	
<i>Cellar Master's Choice</i>

A traditional blend of approximately 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Cabernet Franc and 15% Merlot. It is matured in modern 225 litre French Nevers barrels for 22 to 26 months. It is often described as more elegant than the straight Cabernet Sauvignon.
