•**Tribaut Brut Tradition 595**

Fruity and floral notes on the nose. Very fresh and lively. Fine and delicate on the palate, with hints of dried fruit and apricot flavours.

•**Tribaut Brut Rosé 595**

A fruity and elegant Champagne, dominated with red fruit flavours such as blackcurrant and raspberry. Nice mature complexity on the palate along with a superb light salmon colour.

Méthode Cap Classique

•**Colmant Brut Chardonnay 299**

Delicate light gold colour with a lime-green hue. The nose starts with fresh lemony, floral and green apple notes followed by yeasty and biscuity aromas brought by the lengthy maturation on the lees.

•**Graham Beck Brut or Brut Rosé 269**

The Brut yields a consistent flavour of fresh granny smith apples with overtones of freshly baked biscuits rounded by a creamy yet fresh mouth feel. Rosé, explosive mousse, intensely savoury and generous finish.

Its grilled toast and anise aromas lead to a rich, complex, cracker, yeast and mineral-flavoured personality. It is complex, has excellent to outstanding concentration, and a satiny texture rendered lively with present yet unobtrusive bubbles.

Meaty shiraz, entwines harmoniously with basil and wild watercress. Strains of vanilla, cloves and pink peppercorns.

Crisp, stimulating and rewarding on the palate. The only way to start an evening or luncheon.

•**Simonsig Kaapse Vonkel Brut 239**

Lovely floral aromas, mouth-watering berry flavours of red grapes and a touch of Chardonnay citrus freshness with unmistakable flavours of freshly-baked bread and buttered toast.

Sauvignon Blanc

•**Bouchard Finlayson 219**

This wine has a strong vibrant aroma, tropical fruits of pineapple, litchi and granadilla. This is followed by a firm crisp palate signalling a determined structure with parallel fruit calling one straight back to the glass!

Shows a complex array of tropical fruit, grapefruit and limes all held together by an incredible mineral backbone. The palate is rich and full, made in a style to be a wonderful food companion.

Flavours of passionfruit and ripe mangoes with a long, clean mineral and zesty citrus finish.

•**Delaire Graff Coastal Cuvée 209**

Rich in tropical fruit flavours. These are underpinned by layers of blackcurrant, gooseberry and nettle.

Well-balanced and complex it finishes long with concentrated fruit and fresh, crisp acidity.

An expression of tropical fruit on the nose – gooseberry and passionfruit, with notes of ripe figs, lemongrass and capsicum.

Brilliant greenish in appearance, this is a dramatic wine full of ripe red peppers and passion-fruit which will mature

into mineral and flint.

A typical Thelema Sauvignon Blanc. Lovely fresh melon and grapefruit flavours, with a full, grassy palate, all in perfect balance.

Chardonnay (Unwooded)

•**Diemersdal 139**

Concentrated spicy aromas with fresh fruit flavours. Elegant, rich fruit enhanced by apple and sweet melon. A delicious wine that lingers on the palate.

An unwooded Chardonnay matured on the lees, producing a fresh, lemony-flavoured wine with a yeasty nutty finish.

Glass 35

This is an elegant, fruity Chardonnay. The nose explodes with flavours of fresh citrus and orange blossom.

•**Boschendal (1685) 169**

Elegant, harmonious, fresh lime notes heading gentle butterscotch/oak richness. A dry finish and complete food-friendly nature.

•**Creation 219**

This full-bodied, rich Chardonnay offers a powerful citrus-marmalade and steely backbone. Classic toasty and butterscotch-like characters with mineral undertones. Good balance of oak followed with abundant fruit.

Attractive nut, smoke and orange notes. An easy-going but fresh wine with a firm and creamy texture and well-integrated supportive oak.

Fermented "sur lie" gives this wine lovely creamy tones balanced out with refreshing citrus notes. A cool vintage showcasing this variety's elegance.

The elegant, classic, almond character carries hints of citrus, honey and caramel with a mineral earthiness.

Aromas of stone fruit, citrus and some floral notes. Good fruit structure, voluptuous mouth feel and a long finish.

Glass 39

Grapefruit, melon and citrus flavours jump out of the glass. Mouth-tingling crispness with a long fruit laden finish.

•**Graham Beck The Game Reserve 129**

Full and juicy palate with layers of ripe tropical fruit complemented by a long, clean, crisp and lingering aftertaste.

Glass 35

A youthful wine showing fresh ripe melon with a mellow, round, mild and honeysuckle fruit palate and a refreshingly long finish.

•**Buitenverwachting Buiten Blanc 139**

This full-bodied Sauvignon Blanc based blend offers a variation of fruit characters including ripe gooseberry, green peppers, green melon and hints of tropical fruit.

•**Haute Cabrière Chardonnay/Pinot Noir 189**

Glass 49

Tropical fruit and citrus aromas. Pinot Noir adds a touch of “smoked ham” (of the expensive variety), while the wine leaves on with a whimsical, light finish.

•**Laibach The Ladybird (Organic) 195**

A lovely light straw colour. Complex nose, with hints of lemon and some pineapple. A medium-bodied palate with a creamy yet fresh finish.

A full-flavoured wine with intense aromas of gooseberries, kiwi fruit and crushed nettle. The palate rewards with mouth-filling flavours of tropical fruit and fresh green characters.

•**Cederberg Bukettraube 159**

Glass 39

Exotic, delicate floral and fruit salad aromas, with a hint of honey, dried peach and ripe muscat. All natural sugar with a bracing fresh finish.

•**Hartenberg Riesling 129**

Glass 35

Delicate floral hints with spicy richness. The palate shows layers of soft summer fruits finishing off with a lovely tropical zestiness.

•**Paul Cluver Gewürztraminer 189**

One of the few drier style Gewürztraminers made in South Africa. Highly fragrant with litchi, rose petal and lime aromas leaping from the glass.

Light straw colour. Powerful apricot and peach flavours which mingle with hints of jasmine and lime blossom on the nose. The palate supports the nose by following on the intense fruit flavours.

Medium to full-bodied, with perfectly balanced flavours of blackcurrant, a sprig of mint and a long, silky, juicy finish.

•**Boschkloof 249**

A Shiraz with rich perfumed red berries, vanilla and subtle white pepper aroma. Dark red fruit and spicy oak dominates this soft and elegant wine.

Big, ripe, black fruit. Generous and juicy for lovers of fruit-driven style. Serious and rounded, with vanilla oak spice balancing luscious fruit.

Dark ruby with a vibrant pink rim. Generous red fruit with hints of cassis and pepper on the nose.

•**Dombeya Boulder Road 189**

Dark red fruits, cassis and cherries with an underlying hint of Karoo bush and earthy notes carrying through to intense berry flavours coupled with hints of sage and a black pepper spice finish.

Glass 65

A warm vibrant wine bursting with white pepper and sweet spicy floral tones of jasmine and violets with loads of blackcurrant on the palate.

Rich and full-bodied with dark chocolate and mocha on the palate followed by warm spices and ground pepper. This wine is dense with smooth tannins and a long finish.

The wine introduces you to a ripe complex nose showing flavours of plums, prunes and cinnamon with hints of mixed spice. These deep, intense flavours follow through to a supple, layered and complex palate with the added dimension of dark chocolate.

•**Beyerskloof 149**

Glass 39

Medium to full-bodied with a deep red colour. A complex wine with black and red berry flavours well-integrated with the oak.

•**Diemersdal (Top 10!) 189**

Exotic spices, hints of coffee, vanilla, chocolate and roasted bananas all complemented by the well-integrated oak.

•**Boschendal Sommelier 189**

Rich, ripe and vibrant red and black currants, spice and plums. A classic example of South Africa's very own grape varietal.

•**Ken Forrester Petit 109**

Glass 35

Classic Pinotage aromas of spicy mulberries, plum pudding and cherries, supported by smoky bacon nuances. Juicy and accessible with soft palate and delicious fruit concentration.

Serious and suavely refined. The intense blackberry and purple fruit flavours are well-integrated with the cedar flavours of the French oak.

•**Catherine Marshall 199**

Red fruit, cranberry and wild strawberry with hints of wild mushrooms and a distinct perfumed muskiness. The palate is medium-bodied offering perfectly ripe Pinot red fruit flavours, baking spice and a hint of savoury earthiness.

Deep ruby in colour, gleaming and inviting in the glass. The intensely fragrant bouquet shows a melange of red berry aromas, elegant vanilla and a whiff of wood spice.

The essence of a great Pinot Noir is the purity of fruit and the structure of the wine. Beautiful garnet colour is deeper than previous vintages. Nose is a combination of pepper and red berry, wild mushroom, wild berry compote with a slight meatiness.

Smooth yet complex on the palate: layers of dried fruit mingle with hints of raspberry and piquant spice. A lingering wine with supple tannins to ensure excellent maturation potential.

•Raats Red Jasper (Great Value) 239

This sexy, elegant 80% Cabernet Franc shows the stunning heights this grape can attain! It combines a core of luscious blackberry, black cherry, and plum with expressive notes of cinnamon, tobacco, coffee, and spice.

Red forest berries and tobacco aromas. Rich, ripe mouth feel filled with raspberries and fruit pastilles. Soft, savoury tannins on the palate with a well-balanced finish.

Italian Red Varietals (Grown in S.A.)

•Bouchard Finlayson Hannibal (Great Value) 379

(52% Sangiovese, 14% Nebbiolo, 14% Pinot Noir, 10% Mourvèdre, 3% Shiraz)

This bottling enjoys plenty of character! It is rich and polished with red and black wild berry fruit flavours. Layered with hints of gentle oak leaning light on textured fruit acid and refined tannins driven by a long mineral aftertaste.

•Du Toitskloof Nebbiolo 199

This deep coloured, full-flavoured wine erupts with the seductively scented bouquet of violets.

•Fairview Barbera 179

Smokey nose with shy aromas of dark cherry and raspberry. The wine has a medium palate showing savoury flavours and hints of coriander seed.

•Terra Del Capo Sangiovese 159

Glass 45

Hints of smokiness (cherry tobacco) combined with earthy mineral elements and rich fruit flavours such as prunes, apricots and peaches. This wine has an elegant tannin structure that ends softly with a slightly sweet sensation.

(50% Sangiovese - 50% Merlot)

Fragrant bouquet of red and black fruit – cassis, spice, red cherry and freshly-turned earth. Elegance personified. Rich yet restrained with fresh acidity balancing the ripeness of the blending components on the rounded, sleek palate.

(54% Sangiovese - 28% Barbera - 18% Cab)

Bright ruby in the glass. Fresh berry aromas layered with subtle spice and smoky notes. Light to medium-bodied with young juicy berry flavours, fine integrated oak and smooth tannins.

•Zevenwacht Primitivo 199

A deep, dark, purple-red colour with a cherry-red rim. This wine has an exuberant aroma combining black fruit, plums, dark chocolate, peppery spice and cinnamon. Dense fruit structure, full-bodied plum and dried fruit, supple long tannins with bittersweet dark chocolate mid-palate and a long finish.

•Anthonij Rupert Optima (Great Value) 299



Glass 75

Velvety spice, cocoa, blue and black berry aromas. Sweet and appealing berry compote. Rich fruited plum and berry spice. Bold entry with a chocolatey richness. Delicious! Restrained and elegant.

•Buitenverwachting Meifort 149

Glass 39

Full-bodied and complex red blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Merlot. Warm and inviting nose showing elegant plum, red cherry characters combined with spicy oak and tobacco characters.

•Groote Post Old Mans Blend 119

Creamy opulence, savoury, silky tannins and bright raspberry/cherry freshness. In a word, delicious!

•Joubert Tradauw R62 199

An elegant and classic Bordeaux blend with a bouquet of berries, eucalyptus, mint and cinnamon. Flavours of earth, cedar, blackberries, red currant and cassis; well-centred, supporting a juicy middle palate.

•Laibach The Ladybird (Organic) 219

Medium-bodied palate with hints of crushed blackberries and raspberry. Some mint chocolate aroma and leather also evident. Juicy, almost slippery tannins.

Pleasant cherry, roasted nut and dark chocolate. Cooked beetroot with clove and cinnamon spices in the background mixed with pomegranate flavours.
